



Camper Packing List

Please label all of your child's belongings with their first name and last initial. Please note, we will be doing laundry once a week so pack accordingly! As a reminder, most things will get wet and/or dirty so please bring items that aren't valuable

Everybody:

- Flashlight / Lantern
- Extra blanket if desired (we provide sheets and one blanket)
- Extra pillow if desired (we provide one)
- Hat
- Swim Goggles
- Windbreaker / Raincoat
- Jeans or other long pants (2+)
- Shorts (5+)
- Sweatpants (2)
- Sweatshirt / Sweater
- Swimsuits (at least 2)
- UV/Protective Swim Shirts (if worn normally)
- T-Shirts (7+)
- Long-sleeve T-Shirts (2+)
- Underwear (at least 10 pairs)
- Water Shoes
- Sneakers
- Sandals / Flip Flops
- Socks (a lot!)

Misc Books / Magazines:

- Journal
- Writing Utensils
- Writing Paper
- Envelopes
- Stamps
- Comfort from Home (pictures / posters / stuffed animals, etc.)
- Reusable Water Bottle (at least 2)
- Day Trip Backpack



Toiletries:

- Hand Towels (2)
- Large Towels (4)
- Toiletry Kit or Shower Caddy/ Comb / Brush
- Deodorant
- Feminine Hygiene Products (if applicable)
- Insect Repellant
- Lip Balm (w/ SPF coverage)
- Nail Clippers
- Shampoo
- Soap in Soap Box or liquid soap
- Sunblock (at least 30 SPF, preferably waterproof)
- Tissues
- Toothbrush and holder
- Toothpaste
- Mouthwash (if used)
- Laundry Bag

Medications*

- All prescription bottles WITH camper name (newest prescription/ bottle - please don't put pills in daily pill organizers)
- Inhalers / MDIs (if used) and spares
 - Spacers (if used)
- Epipens (if used)
- Pill Crusher (if used)
- Pill Splitter (if used) - please do not pre-cut medication, our nurse is required to do that
- Allergy Medication (if used)
- Over the counter medications or vitamins used - these MUST be listed on the medical form and signed off on by the physician

Everything needs to be placed in a big Ziplock bag or container that is labeled with the camper's name.

All medications (OTC and prescriptions) will be given to on arrival, managed by, and dispensed by the Health Team.



If You Have These, and Would Like to Bring...

- Sleeping bag (a campout night will be an option during the summer)
- Tennis Racket
- Soccer Cleats
- Shin Guards
- Go Pro
- Camera (not attached to phone)
- Tablet or phone (these will be kept secured and charging when not in use, see note below)

- 1 Camp Reece Sweatshirt
- 1 sheet set (twin XL)
- 1 blanket
- 1 pillow
- 1 pillowcase

A Note on Electronics:

As discussed during the interview process, Camp Reece allows electronics on a very limited basis, during designated times at staff discretion. When not in use, electronics will be kept in a locked and secure location. Camp Reece will not be responsible for the loss and/or damage of any camper's electronic equipment, including but not limited to cell phones, tablets, Kindles, cords, and chargers. If you do decide to pack electronics, please LABEL everything (including cords, chargers, etc.). If you are unsure about if an electronic is allowed, please reach out.



What NOT to Bring

Camp is not the place for expensive or valued items. Please leave the following items at home:

- Expensive/ invaluable clothing and jewelry
- Weapons, including pocket knives or other sharp objects
- Cigarettes, vapes, alcohol and drugs of any kind are not permitted at camp under any circumstance
- Food (please speak with Camp Director for exceptions)
- Flammables/ Explosives

Camp Reece is not responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged items.

We will not replace any items.

Pets

Interacting with animals and nature is a great part of the Camp Reece experience and campers will have the opportunity to interact with our farm animals as well as campus approved dogs. For the safety of our campers, staff and animals we request that camp families not bring any pets to drop off or pick up at summer camp.
